Rocker Cover Competition Guidelines - Friday 4th September 2020

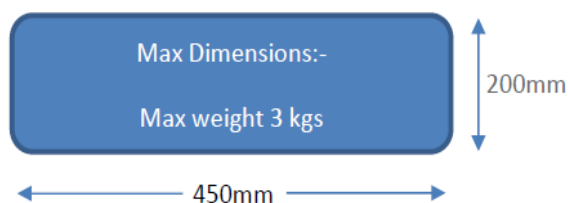
Rocker Cover Racers must be presented for scrutineering at the Conference Centre by 16:30.

After scrutineering, a Concours competition will be held at 17:00 – drivers will be photographed with their cars.

Racing will begin at 17:30 in the Conference Centre.

Rocker racers:-

- 1 – The racers shall have no power source. All motive force to be provided by gravity.
- 2 – Racers shall be based on a rocker cover from a 4-cylinder MG or BMC automobile engine.
- 3 – The overall length of the racer shall not exceed 450 mm.
- 4 – The overall width of the racer shall not exceed 200mm.
- 5 – Racers shall have 4 wheels, each no more than 150mm in diameter.
- 6 – The maximum weight shall not exceed 3 kg.



The Course:-

- 1 – The course shall consist of a launch incline 1.5m long followed by a level run of 6.0 metres.
- 2 – The launch incline shall consist of two lanes, each 450mm wide. The incline shall be 700mm high at the rearmost part and level with the course at the front edge. The front edge shall be bevelled so as to provide a smooth transition from the incline to the run out area.
3. The official "Starting Line" shall be 500 mm from the rear edge of the incline. A mechanised starting gate may be provided.
- 4 – The run out section of the course shall provide two lanes, each 450mm wide.
- 5 – The finish line shall be marked 6.0 metres from the front edge of the launch incline.

The Race:-

- 1 - The competition shall be conducted in heats of two racers at a time. Pairs of cars will be randomly selected for the first round of heats.
- 2 – The first racer to cross the finishing line is the winner of the heat. If neither racer makes it to the finish line, the racer going the furthest will be declared the winner of that heat.
- 3 – Heat winners race until all are eliminated except one racer, which will be the outright winner.
