This is the second newsletter for the 2020 Indaba.

How time flies, when we started the Indaba planning 18 months ago it seemed so distant, but now with only 11 months to go it's much closer and is now almost in touching distance.

Our on-site accommodation at Kleinplaas is now almost fully subscribed. There are only a few opportunities remaining for anyone who is prepared to share a 2-bedroom chalet with another couple.

The accommodation we have been allocated at the nearby Protea Hotel Riempie Estate is fully subscribed. We have asked for more rooms to be made available to us, but have no guarantee of this at this stage.

This means that future entrants to the Indaba will either need to make their own accommodation (B&B) arrangements, or request for their names to be added to a waiting list should vacancies arise at either Kleinplaas or the Protea Hotel Riempie Estate.
